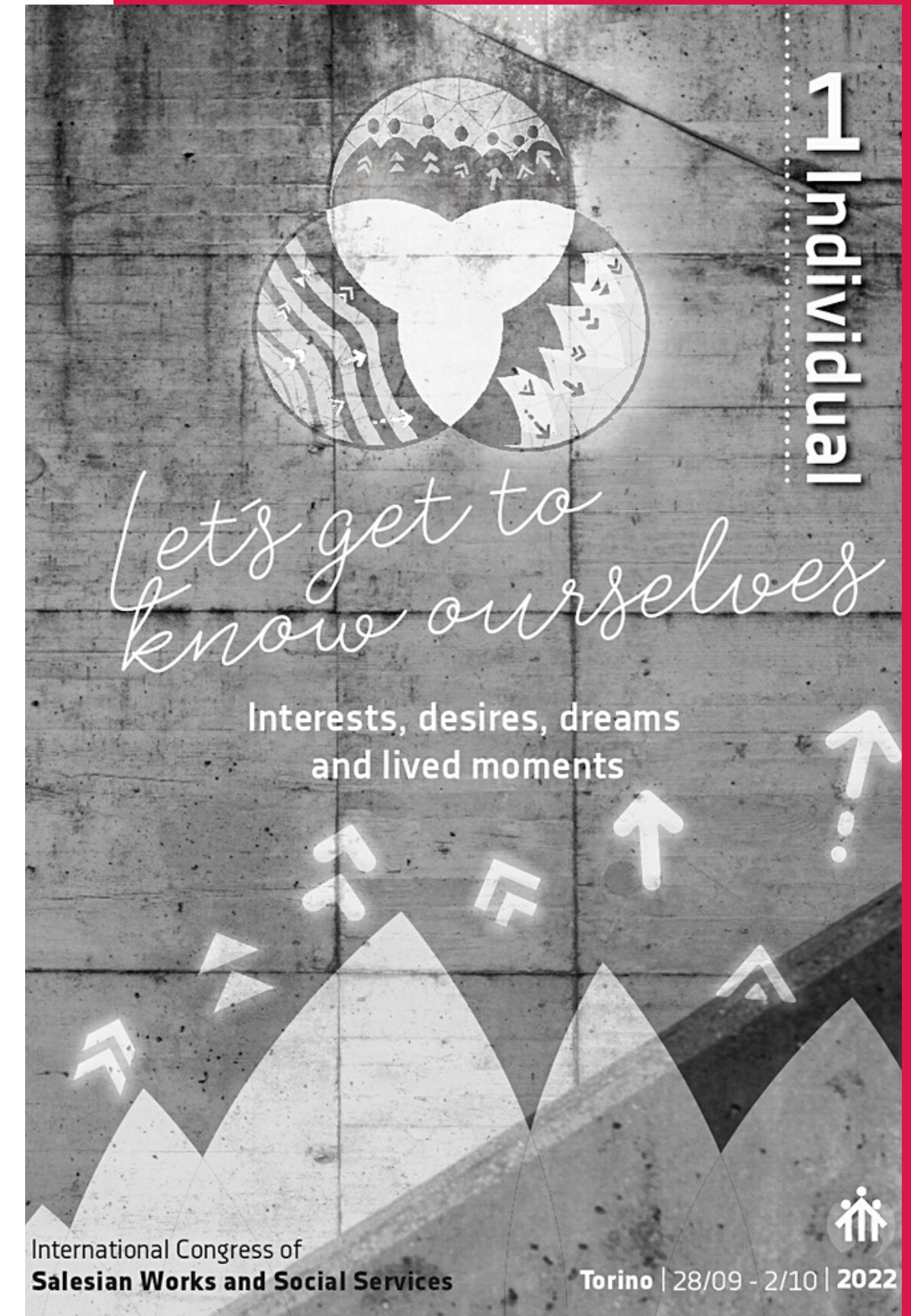

Introduction

The Congress of the Social Works of the Salesian Congregation is a product of the desire of the Salesians of Don Bosco to guarantee and strengthen the Social Works sector as a sector of Youth Ministry at a formal level.

For this, there are many voices coming together, from more than 134 countries and 91 Provinces. Those who make decisions at the political level, those who think of the Preventive System from the Salesian Pedagogy, those who think of evangelisation among the poorest... and, of course, a very important voice is that of young people who, as General Chapter 28 says: we must open forums for young people to express themselves, and not be recipients of the mission but partners of the laity and of the Salesians who carry out the works, from which we want to promote development among the poorest.

This is why this team of lay people and young people seek to make a contribution to this great Congress, as an experiential space resulting from the experience of the different Social Works and their services in the 5 continents. Being representatives of so many young people, children and adolescents who have benefited from these services and who today are transforming society, being signs of law and justice among those whose rights have been violated, in order to achieve a more just society, a society that lives together in peace.
